Pastoral Letter from Seung Jae, Minister at Boronia Park Uniting Church

I, on behalf of the congregation's leadership, would say, 'peace be with you.' We believe that the peace that now we have or anticipate is given from God the Father. It is fulfilled by the mystery in Christ's ministry – his journey toward the crucifixion and the resurrection. Now we are on that journey being with Christ and His eternal peace. Whether the peace given from God is visible or not, we are called to seek to find the peace in self, home, family, community and church. Once again, the peace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you all.

We are today going through the great storm of COVID-19 epidemic. In accordance to the government's and church's guideline, we have done so well in keeping away as well as keeping connected in spirit. The decision that Boronia Park Uniting Church's services including Sunday worship are suspended until further notice has been difficult for us to think about who we are as Church. Before the decision of suspension, we gathered every Sunday to worship and to have fellowship, affirming that we, as Church, are able to continue this faith journey. And now we do the same thing in spirit wherever we are. Way that we are practicing it looks a bit different but exactly the same way we are carrying on our journey with Christ. Jesus Christ, the Son of God and Man, lives from the Creation as the Word to the End via his time being with those who never dreamed about being in the kingdom of God because of their social isolation by power and authority. Nothing stops Jesus. In the same way, nothing stops us as we continue the journey of faith where we would stand against all hinderances for us to give up our relationship with Jesus Christ and to show the peace, no matter how little it is in your spirit, to those around you. As the peace of Christ Jesus has been delivered to you by the Holy Spirit, your peace goes to touch people near you who desperately need it today.

I hope that 2020 Easter Day (Sunday 12 April) will be significant because we will celebrate it at home as the disciples and followers did on the first day of Christ's resurrection. It would be very biblical experience for you and for many that the songs of praises for Christ's resurrection echo to each other in spirit from Hunters Hill to Strathfield, from Tennyson Point to Denistone, and from wherever you are to Ryde. Imagine all of us celebrate Easter Day as the first Christians celebrated it.
